#### Rule of the month

Please respect the tow away zones on harbor property. All tow away zones are there for safety reasons and are marked with red paint.

§15-213-22 Tow zone or tow-away zone. Any county police officer, Kewalo basin security vendor, state law enforcement officer, or special police officer may remove or cause to be removed any vehicle that is left unattended or parked in a tow zone or tow-away zone at all hours of any day on the streets or portions thereof.

Even if you don't expect mail, come and check we get plenty of business mail that does not get picked up. You can pick up your mail or packages between the hours of 8:30am-4:30pm everyday.

## NO Parking in Kewalo Basin Park

This month, Friends of Kewalo's reached out to us regarding ongoing parking violations in Kewalo Basin Park. As a reminder to vessel owners, staff, and visitors: **please do not park your vehicle in the park.** 

If you notice that your customers or staff have parked there, kindly encourage them to move their vehicles to available parking lots, including the Harbor lot, HCDA lot, or OHA lot. Let's all do our part to be good neighbors and keep the park parking spaces open for park users. We also encourage everyone to use public transportation when visiting Kewalo Harbor to help reduce parking demand.

Lastly, remember that loading zones are limited to a 20-minute time limit.

## Stormwater BMP Tip

In addition to your normal oil-changing preparations (purchasing the correct type and amount of oil, gathering the necessary tools), place catch pans and oil-absorbent pads beneath the engine and oil filter before starting. This adds an extra layer of protection to keep accidental spills from reaching the bilge.
